Among the 50 states, **Indiana Ranks:**

- 34th in 1st trimester entry into **prenatal care** (78.8%)
- 37th in **preterm birth** (13.4%)
- 27th in **low birth weight** (8.2%)
- 39th in **infant mortality** (7.5 Overall; 6.5 White, 15.7 Black)
- 43rd in the percentage of **women smoking during pregnancy** (17.3%)
- Overall State Health Rank: **32nd healthiest**

Persuaded Medicaid officials to implement Presumptive Eligibility for pregnant women resulting in nearly 7,000 women enrolling in Medicaid in a more timely manner

Launched a new, comprehensive website visited nearly 10,000 times, by individuals from 68 Indiana counties, 46 states and 32 foreign countries



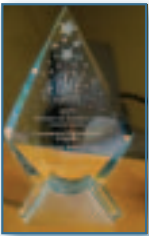
Published our first Annual Educational Offerings Catalog and launched our first series of regional workshops

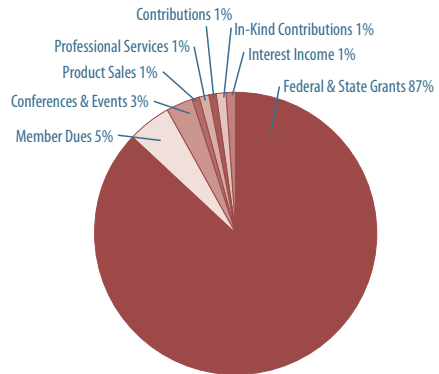

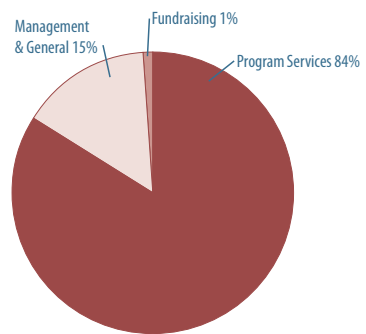
