



PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Indiana Perinatal Network (IPN) collects personal information from its members and other constituents on a voluntary basis. The personal information collected is limited to that which is necessary to provide its members and other constituents with high quality service and benefits. This information may include such items as name, address, employer, business address, credit card number, email address, etc. Electronic data is stored on a secure server with restricted access.

Information is used to conduct business transactions such as processing event registrations, resource orders, and member dues as well as conduct general correspondence regarding perinatal health. This information may also be used to identify industry segments, interests and purchasing patterns in order to customize the marketing of our products and services.

IPN does not sell, rent or transmit personal information to other organizations unless we have formed a partnership to enhance products or services we offer and that organization has agreed to comply with this policy.

We may, however, collect standard aggregate data such as pages visited and files downloaded to help us design our website and to report our impact to grantors.
