| Emergency Department Consensus Statement Tina Babbitt | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Have been asked by ISDH to revise and develop the Emergency Department Consensus Statement to clarify procedures and protocols for pregnant women coming into ER or find out at ER they are pregnant. -ER often doesn't have knowledge to take care of pregnant women. Often come to -ER because don't have access to care or provider far away and need assistance. -How can we provide support to ER in providing care. - There are critical access hospitals that don't provide OB care. -Tina Babbitt is the lead contact person and invites anyone interested in working on committee to help with revision. <p>Short-lived committee-needs to be finished by end of September. Already recruited Dana Watters, Bloomington Hospital and Joe Landwehr, Ball Memorial.</p> |
| ISDH Update Beth Johnson | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -28% cesarean rate in Indiana. A 40% increase. Overall 83% increase among black population. -Every 5 years state does needs assessment for title 5. After have data will list on website. Would like to have input from everyone. Will help choose state indicators -Elkhart has highest unemployment rate and highest undocumented Hispanic |

| <p>Legislative Update (handout) Caitlin Priest</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Very busy session. All bills have been either looked at or discarded. Bills are in process of being viewed by other chambers. -Smoking ban in public places passed by House in heavily amended form excluding bars and casinos. It is now in Senate and sponsors are advocating only for an unamended form but don't think it will be passed. -Working with MOD around non smoking tobacco products. Provision that would require dept of revenue to use stamp on smokeless tobacco would be taxed as other tobacco products bring taxation levels up. The money would be used to support activity of prenatal substance use commission. -IPN welcomes all feedback about what would like to see for next year |
